

From Tuscarawas County, Ohio Cemeteries - Volume IV  
Located in Sandy Township, Tuscarawas County, Ohio

- SA112 Black Family Cemetery  
From State Route 800 south of Mineral City, take Township Road 47 (Sattler Bottom Road) east about 1-1/4 miles. There is nothing left, but it was beside drive on Earl Boyd farm. [T.10, R.1, SW comer of Lot 25.]
- SA113 Farber Family Cemetery  
From Mineral City, take State Route 800 north to State Route 183 east to Bertha Howenstine property near Carroll County line. (Midway between Magnolia and Sandyville). [T.10,R.1,SW comer of Lot 7].  
Coordinates: N 40° 38' 37.59", W 81° 19' 39.64"
- SA114 Hough Cemetery  
From Mineral City. Take State Route 800 southwest to State Route 212. Take 212 west towards Zoar, approximately 1 mile before County Road 106 (Tusky Valley Road), access drive goes northeast to wood. Walk into fields to 2 rows of trees, follow right row; 20-30 feet before ravine - stones are leaning against tree in fence row. (Pritchard farm). [T.10,R.1]
- SA115 Lower Sandyville Cemetery  
Located in Sandyville. From Mineral City take State Route 800 north to County Road 108 (Crossroads Road) west to 5-way stop. Immediate left onto County road 107 (Sandyville Road); cemetery is on the right side of the road in Sandyville. [T.10, R.1.]  
Coordinates: N 40° 38' 19.5", W 81° 22' 28.24"
- SA116 Mineral City Cemetery  
Located in Mineral City. Go north on State Route 800, cross railroad tracks and turn right, cemetery is on steep hill near school.  
Coordinates: N 40° 36' 9.72", W 81° 21' 31.87"
- SA117 Mineral City Catholic Cemetery  
Located in Mineral City. Go north on State Route 800, turn right at first light.  
Coordinates: N 40° 36' 6.93", W 81° 21' 14.05"
- SA118 Octagon Cemetery  
Take State Route 800 north from Mineral City to State Route 183. Turn east on State Route 183 to road on left just east of old Octagon school, now a residence. Follow gas company road 1-1/4 miles to gas well, where cemetery is located. You must get a key from McDade to unlock gate. [T.10, R.1, NE comer of Lot 14.]
- SA119 Old German (Mineral City) Cemetery  
Take State Route 800 north of Mineral City to first stoplight, turn right on Township Road 401 (German Cemetery Road); make a left and cemetery is in junction of Township Roads 109 (Fairview Road) and 401 (German Cemetery Road). [T.10,R.1, SE comer of Lot 4.]  
Coordinates: N 40° 36' 35", W 81° 21' 11.4"
- SA120 Pleasant Valley (Old Methodist) - Sparks Family Cemetery  
From State Route 800 in Mineral City, take County Road 90 (New Cumberland Road) southeast approximately 2-1/2 miles to abandoned Township Road 47 (Edwards Road), now a gas well road. Travel 1/2 miles, cemetery is on right hand side of road. (Walk T.47, unless it is very dry.)  
Coordinates: N 40° 34' 46", W 81° 19' 56"

SA121 Render Family Cemetery

Take County Road 90 (New Cumberland Road) southeast from Mineral City to Township Road 48. This cemetery may be reached by going through James Brothers' Coal Mine starting at the office on County Road 110 (Lindentree Road) or by obtaining permission from Mr. McNutt (section 12 off County Road 90.) The cemetery sits atop a point, along the gas line which runs through the James Brothers' property. This area has been stripped around the cemetery. [T.1 0, R.1, NE corner of section 17.]

SA122 Sandyville Greenlawn Cemetery (Evergreen)

Located in Sandyville. From State Route 800, take County Road 108 (Crossroads Road) west to County Road 104 (Ridge Road). Take County Road 104 (Ridge Road) north in Sandyville, cemetery is on the left. Coordinates: N 40° 38' 30.11", W 81° 22' 25.4"
