The Dennison Railroad Depot Museum is located in a beautifully restored 1873 Pennsylvania Railroad Train Depot with exhibits for every age sharing life in the Dennison Train Yard. To walk through history to enjoy railroad memorabilia, including a model train display of what the Dennison Yard once looked like at the turn of the century. Visit our five fully restored passenger cars with exhibits including the Children's Interactive Experience Car, special exhibits car, local history car, and rare WWII Hospital Car that opens pages of history when the Depot was the most memorable Salvation Army Serviceman's Canteen. Over the duration of the War, the Canteen serviced over 1.5 million servicemen 24 hours a day with free coffee, sandwiches, and friendly smiles... hospitality that gave Dennison the name Dreamsville, U.S.A. Today groups cannot only find these same smiling faces and a free cup of coffee but experience all of the Depot including its theatre and Whistle Stop Railway Shop.

Admission includes the choice of a free commemorative dog tag or canteen cookie with a full guided tour through the Museum. Enjoy a catered dinner in the theatre by taking a look at our dining options. Let us help you visit the surrounding community to experience the Uhrichville Clay Museum, Railway Chapel, and historic Union Cemetery. Watch the calendar of year round events including the magical Polar Express and American Soldiers Homecoming Festival.
